## *Personal Patient Connection:*

Start by checking in with the patient. After all, they're not just a set of teeth – treat them as if they were friends/family! What's the latest in school or work? Any exciting plans on the horizon? This is your secret gateway to building a connection.

## *Who's in the Entourage?:*

Quick detective work! Find out who's accompanying your patient – is it Mom, Dad, or did they brave the appointment alone? Knowing this sets the stage for post-appointment communication. You're the Sherlock Holmes of assisting!

## *Doctor's Orders:*

Be prepared and READ the treatment plan! Remember, your doc relies on your preparedness to make it smooth sailing. Understand the big picture of your patient's treatment journey, not just today's goals!

## *The Records Saga:*

Dive into the patient's records. It's like traveling back in time – where did they start, and where are they now? Assess if updated records are needed, and this is the perfect moment to show your patient how far they've come.

## *Clinical Check:*

Channel your inner timekeeper. How many months deep are we into this treatment? Are we right on schedule, ahead of the game, or slightly behind? Know the current wire size, aligner number, elastic type, and whether they're following the daytime or nighttime elastic ritual. Bite turbos, broken appliances – inspect and report!

## *Appointment Alignment:*

Is today's appointment on track, or does it need a little shake up? Remember, just because it's on the schedule doesn't mean it's what your patient needs. Be prepared to clue your doc in on what you've uncovered.

## *What's Next, Detective?:*

Think ahead – what should the next appointment be, and why? Challenge yourself! It's not just about waiting for the doc's orders; your input MATTERS.

## *Paging Doctor:*

Before you hit that summoning button, check if the doctor is needed elsewhere FIRST. Be aware of the clinical symphony – sometimes, it's best for your doc to make a pit stop at a few other appointments before yours. This keeps the flow flowing smoothly. Location? You're in the driver's seat, making sure the show runs without a bump!
